## Updating Your COOP Agreements

A continuity of operations (COOP) plan is one of the most effective defenses against business or agency interruptions due to incidents and events, whether local or wide-spread. A COOP plan provides for the continuity of an organization's essential functions and services in the midst of an emergency. Key elements of most COOP plans are up-to-date memoranda of agreement (MOA). MOAs establish the responsibilities of parties involved in COOP assistance. This type of agreement is frequently used to establish alternate work locations, access to special equipment or critical services. Executed MOAs should be reviewed regularly for

necessary updates. Even an out-of-date phone number can cause a critical delay during an emergency. Tests, training and exercises can help identify gaps in a COOP plan. For example, last year's "Hurricane Charlie" state exercise revealed inconsistent internet availability at one of the specified alternate locations. The identified gap was addressed with the service provider, ensuring that the location had consistent connections and adequate speeds to continue operations. No COOP plan addresses every eventuality. Effective plans, however, support good decision making in the midst of a crisis. For more information, or to comment, contact [Chuck Phinney](#).

## Exercise Program Spotlight

The Exercise Unit worked for several months with state agency partners to develop the state's first Texas Training and Exercise Plan (TxTEP). The three-year (2018-2020) plan includes a list of exercises, conferences, and state operations- and exercise-related training classes. The TxTEP calendar will be part of the State Operations Center weekly Statewide Pre-Planned Events update. The goal is to provide situational awareness and help agencies deconflict exercise schedules. ## Local and Regional Planning Update

On January 5<sup>th</sup>, Local and Regional Plans Unit staff attended the Large-Scale Aviation Accident Response Workshop in Denton, Texas. The workshop was hosted by the City of Dallas and sponsored by FEMA in partnership with the National Transportation Safety Board. The workshop provided emergency management personnel with federal policies, procedures and methods to support their ability to respond to and recover from a large-scale aviation accident. Workshop objectives included—

- Coordinating accident investigations through whole community involvement;
- Meeting the needs of survivors and families of victims;
- Achieving unified public messaging;
- Understanding existing local state and federal capabilities;
- Identifying response resources, and avoiding potential shortfalls and duplication of effort.
