## **A Clear Path to Emergency Assistance in Texas**

What happens when a rapidly expanding incident or disaster threatens to overwhelm a local jurisdiction's ability to manage it? Faced with uncertainty and intense public pressure, a local official may be tempted to call in the cavalry. Often, however, who the cavalry is depends on the local official's understanding of emergency management. For instance, if a mayor or county judge is unfamiliar with the National Incident Management System (NIMS) and Texas' system for managing disasters, that official could reach out to almost anyone, wasting critical time needed to get the right people and resources in place. As we know, the jurisdiction's emergency management coordinator (EMC), supported by TDEM's district coordinator (DC), is responsible for assessing the situation and bringing the right resources to bear on the situation as it unfolds. From here the process is straightforward. If the

jurisdiction's resources are or will be overwhelmed, requests for help follow this sequence:

- Neighboring jurisdiction(s), usually under the terms of a mutual aid agreement (MAA)
- County
- Disaster District Committee (DDC)
- State Operations Center (SOC)
- Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA)\*

If local officials try to blaze their own trail, they will eventually be steered back to the established sequence. Why? Because successful response depends on a coordinated, common understanding of the situation by, and communication among, emergency response professionals trained to deal with complex, rapidly expanding incidents. ## State of Texas Preparedness Exercise Program Updates

We are often asked if a planning meeting leading up to a scheduled, special event counts towards Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) exercise credit. Regular planning meetings for scheduled events, such as a parade, county fair, or concert do not count toward exercise credit. However, a special event planning workshop may count as a discussion-based exercise if it fulfills basic EMPG planning workshop criteria. To receive credit for an exercise, you must submit an Exercise Notification Form to TDEM, as well as an After Action Report and Improvement Plan (AAR/IP). ## Local and Regional Planning Spotlight

In January 2017, the City of Austin and Travis County hosted the National Alliance for Public Safety GIS (NAPSG) Foundation Flood Workshop. The workshop included speakers from TDEM, Hays County, the City of Austin, and the National Weather Service. The eight-hour event covered historical flood events and provided flood mitigation techniques to participants. The workshop culminated with an exercise designed to foster communication among jurisdictions. Such workshops are a best practice, allowing regional partners to work together on planning and providing an opportunity for continued relationship-building. In
